

The following is information on bivvy bags and first aid kits that will pass tech inspection.

**Bivy-Bag. Rule 3.14.5**

One (1) substantial bivvy-bag (no space blankets) or equivalent.

The reflective mylar space blankets are no longer approved. Anything listed for emergency use or as an emergency blanket will not be approved. The bivvy bag needs to be made with reinforced material, capable of being reused.

SOL has several models that will pass tech inspection. They are -

Thermal Bivvy, Escape Light Bivvy, and Escape with Hood.

Conventional camping Bivvy bags will pass, and there are several models that are reasonably priced. One being the ALPS Mountaineering Stealth 1 available at REI.

**First Aid Kit Rule 3.15.2 - one per team / 2 riders.**

The first aid kit needs to be a multipurpose kit, rated for 2-3 people, for 2-3 days, weighing a minimum of 7 ounces.

Trauma kits can be used to supplement the first aid kit but will not be approved if that is the only kit submitted.

Examples of approved kits are -

**Adventure Medical**

Sportsman 100, rated for 2 people 4 days.

Adventure rated 1-2 people.

Mountain Series, 2 people 2 days

**Hart Outdoor**

Weekend kit, 3 people 2 days

All of these are in the \$ 30 – 40\$ range.

These are available at REI, Bass Pro / Cabela's, Eagle Enterprises, B&J Sporting Goods, Sportsman Warehouse.
